We support local alpaca farmers and promote natural sustainable dyeing methods.


At Millma, we believe in preserving traditional handcrafts, spinning and knitting.

Hand spinning is an artisanal process whereby the raw alpaca gibre is spun using an ancient tool called a PUSHKA.

Women in the highlands of Peru have been using this skill for centuries from generation to generation.

Peru has a rich history of natural dyeing. We promote sustainability and eco dyes which nature offers, such as plants, vegetables, wood, cochineal and minerals.

By using these dyes, we are building a supply chain which does not damage the environment.
