

More than \$ 600 million is the investment made by the current government administration in the province of Chiriquí in housing projects, potable water and sewage, roads, education, health and sports.

- ▶ Chiriqui province is home to many coffee plantations, most of them in and around the Boquete and Volcan areas. This is due to the ideal conditions such as high elevation, cool nights, brisk winds, and volcanic soil. Coffee fincas (farms) run the gamut from small “hobby” growers to huge, sophisticated specialty coffee operations, resulting in Panamanian coffee being prized throughout Europe, Japan, and other countries. Some varieties, such as geisha, bring shockingly high prices at coffee auctions worldwide.
- ▶ Coffee growing in Panama began in the early nineteenth century, the initial plants being brought here by a retired sea captain. The 1905 census revealed that there were from five to eight growers by that time. During the ensuing years very little focus was directed on any specific flavor until the influx of ex-pats from the US and Canada a few decades ago.

Over five coffee varieties are now produced in this country. One of these, geisha coffee, is recognizable by its elongated beans (cherries, as they are correctly called). No, contrary to popular belief, coffee beans do not start out being that lovely soft brown color, but bright red while on the plants). This high quality variety is very popular and enjoyed by coffee enthusiasts around the world. It has a floral, yet fruity aroma and a full-bodied taste. Hacienda La Esmeralda produces some of the finest geisha coffee in the world and has won numerous international competitions. Each year a particularly prestigious event is held in Boquete, Chiriqui, Panama. Called "The Best of Panama", it is the yearly gathering of an international tasting event organized by the Specialty Coffee Association of Panama. Its goal is to rank the many talented coffee producers in this small country.

Coffee experts from all over the world observe the eighteen judges as they test each entry for taste, aroma, body, and consistency.
